Monday	One Way	Matthew 5-7 (various texts from the Sermon on the Mount)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand that we all have different faith journeys but we all get to the same place • see that the Bible provides guidance for our trip – it has what we need • understand that the Christian community helps us prepare for our journey (baptism, camp, SS, worship, adults)
Tuesday	Scenic View	Luke 19:1-10 or Luke 24:13-35 or Acts 8:26-39 (specific scripture is determined by age of campers)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • count their blessings and be thankful for what we have • understand that good things/experiences bring us closer to God • understand that everything good comes from God
Wednesday	Detour Ahead	John 20:24-27 Matthew 14:22-33 Jonah (Day Camp)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand that we will face challenges and doubts on our journey • realize that God makes good of bad situations • begin to understand that it is our choices not God that causes us to feel distant from God
Thursday	Rest Stop	Mark 5:24-34 Matthew 11:28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand that we find rest and peace in Christ • understand that to continue our journey we need to be renewed and filled • understand that this is a life long journey and we can't stop
Friday	Pictures and Postcards	Mark 3:1-5 Luke 18:35-43 John 6:1-15 Mark 6:53-56 John 20:11-18 Matthew 28:18-20	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand that they need to share their faith with others • remember that God is always with them on their journey
